PROJECT PURPOSE

- Efficiently utilize predominately residential on-street parking areas, particularly for neighborhood residents.
- Balance neighborhood resident parking needs with that of business owners, contractors, and visitors.
- Comprehensively evaluate the RPP program to identify potential improvements.

SYSTEM OVERVIEW

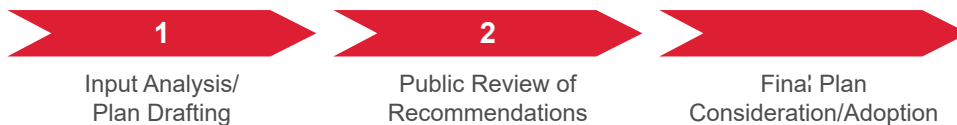
- 16 Permit Districts with more than 4,000 RPP-designated spaces.
- 3,544 permits-issued in 2024 (includes 1,411 visitor permits).
- Four Permit Types: Residential, Conditional, Contractor, and Visitor.

How can you help improve the Residential Permit Parking Program?

The RPP Program is used to manage limited parking supply in several Lancaster neighborhoods. The City is studying this program to find ways to increase parking access. Local knowledge from residents, business owners, and contractors is crucial to this effort. By participating in engagement events, you are contributing to an improved RPP Program.

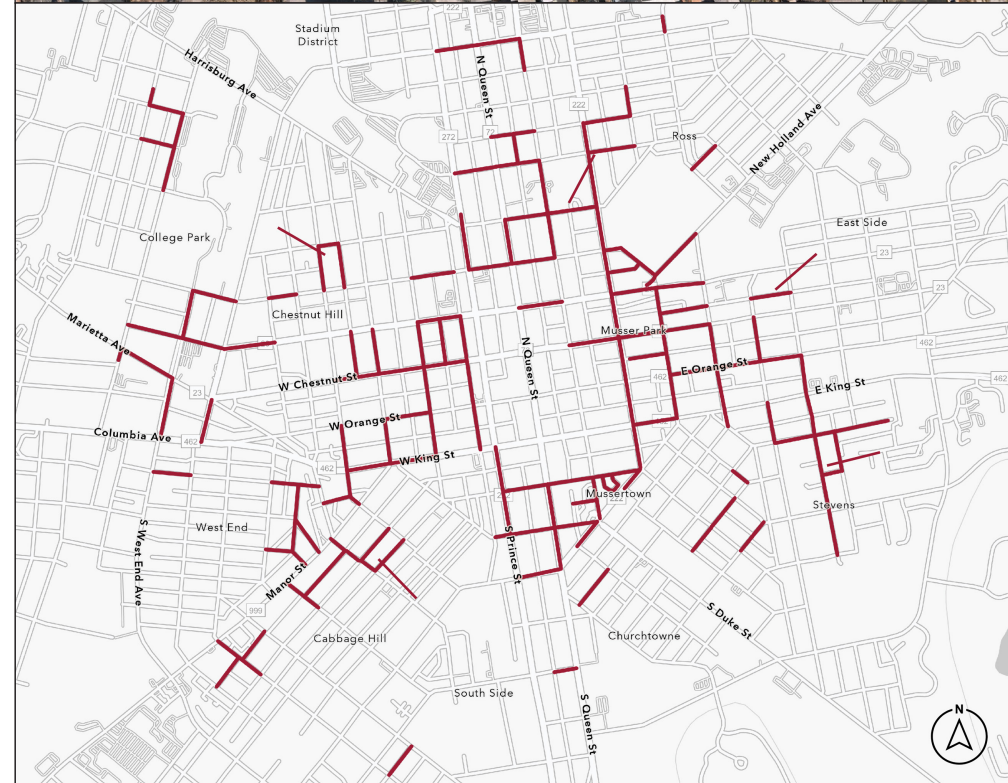
How will my feedback be used?
