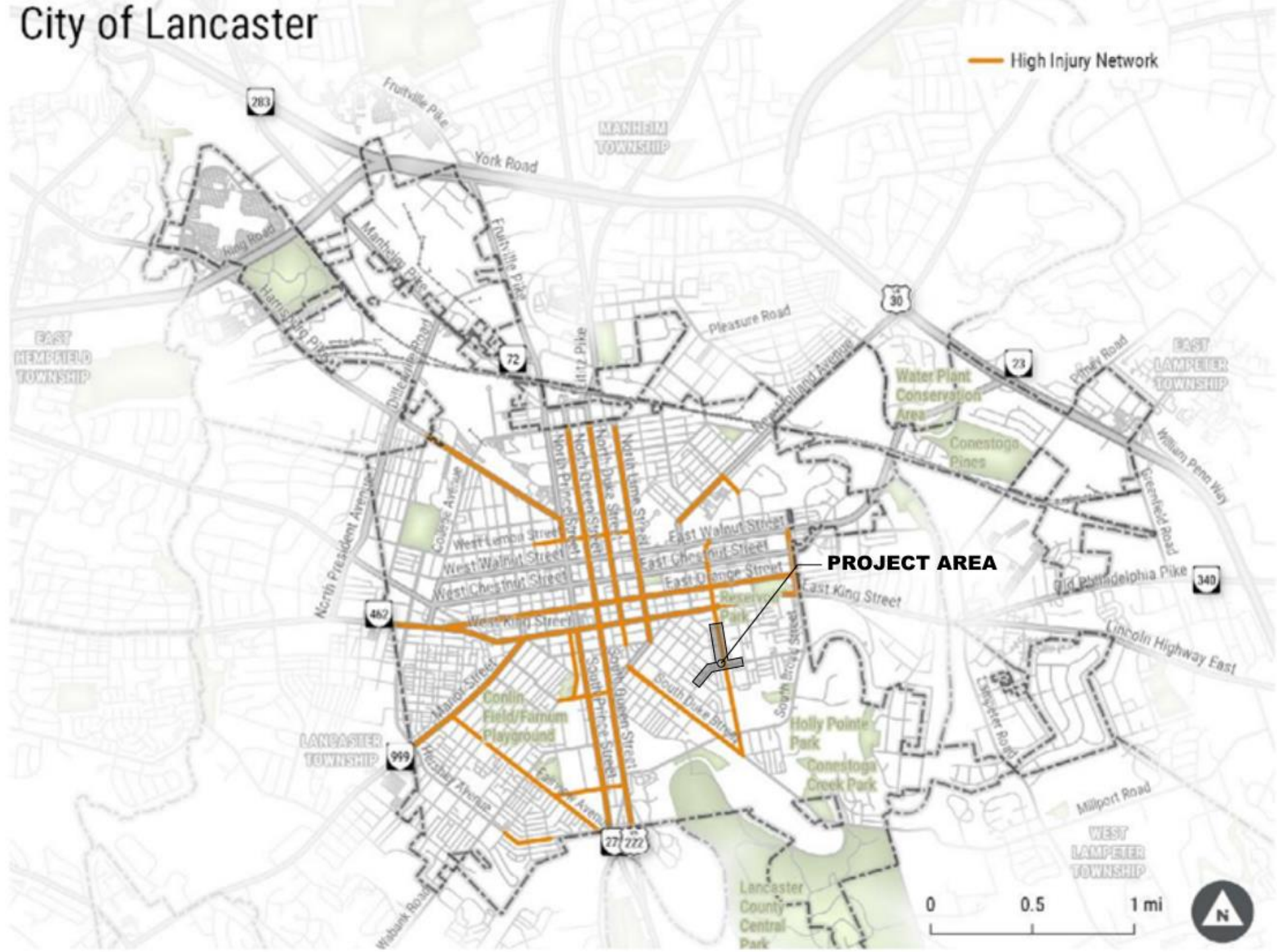
PREVIOUS PLANNING EFFORTS



Vision Zero Lancaster –

- Safety
 - Higher concentration of crashes in low-income communities
 - Concerns include speeding and failure to yield to pedestrians
 - S. Ann Street on High Injury Network
 - Suggest measures to slow right turn, enhance crosswalk visibility

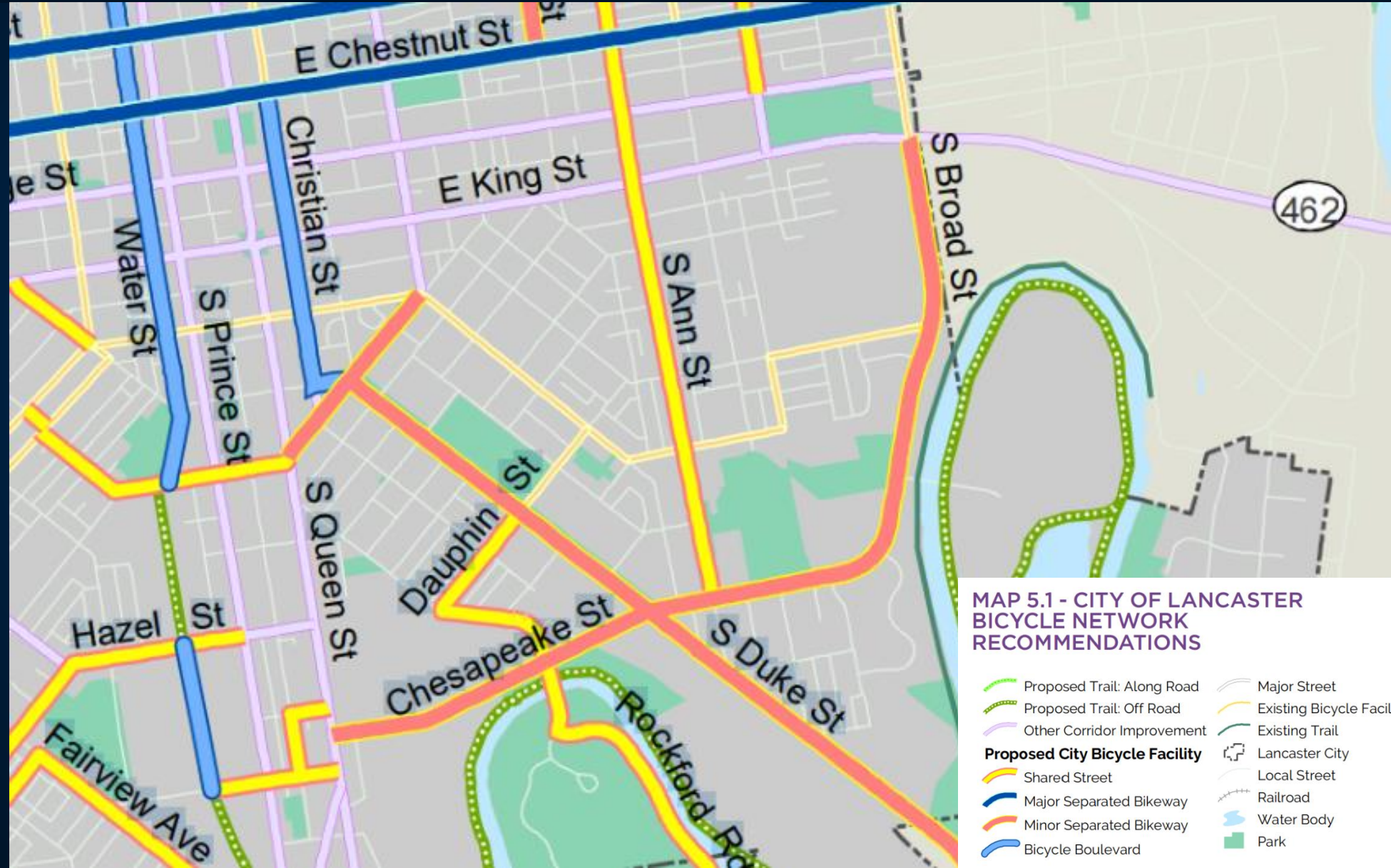

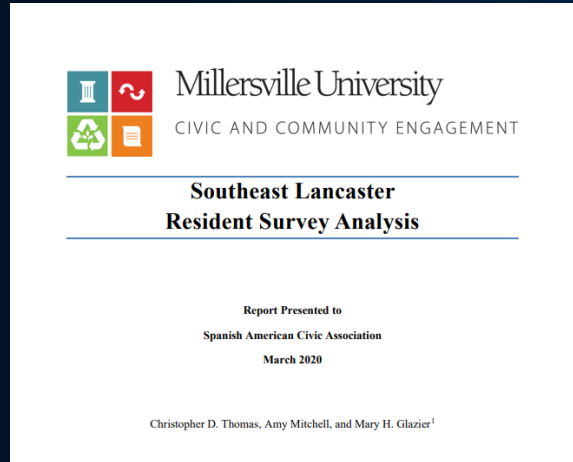
Lancaster Active Transportation Plan –

 - Desire more on-street parking (Lime Street)

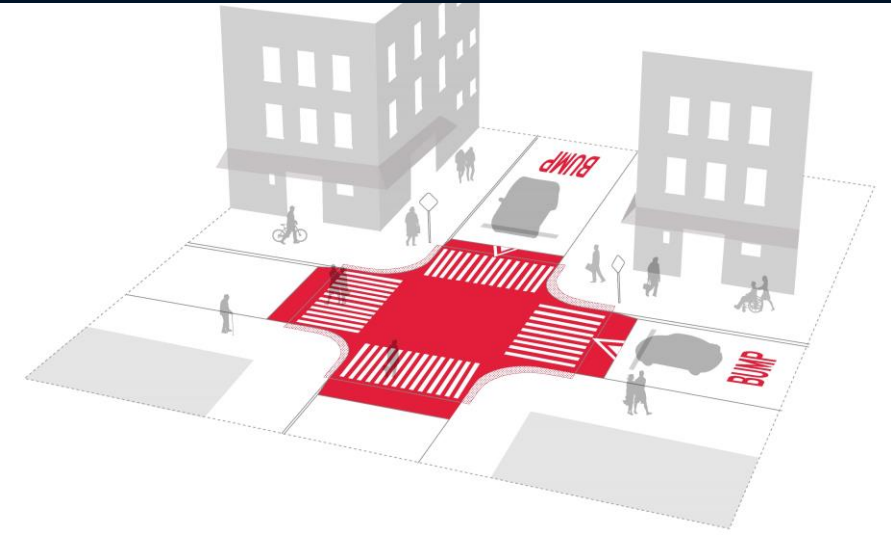

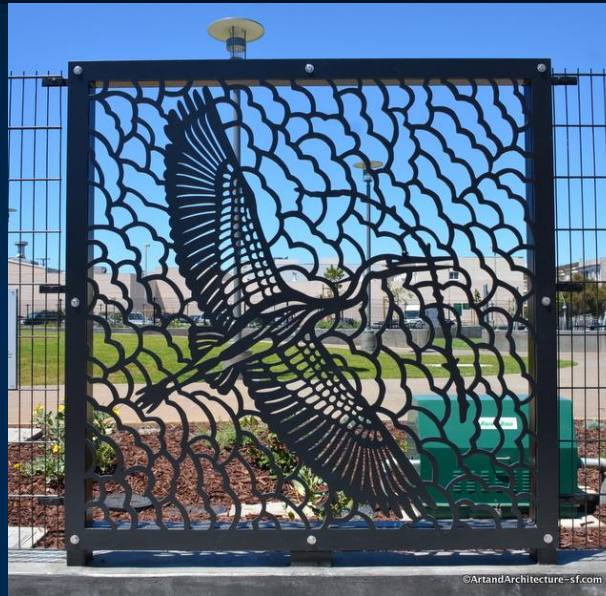
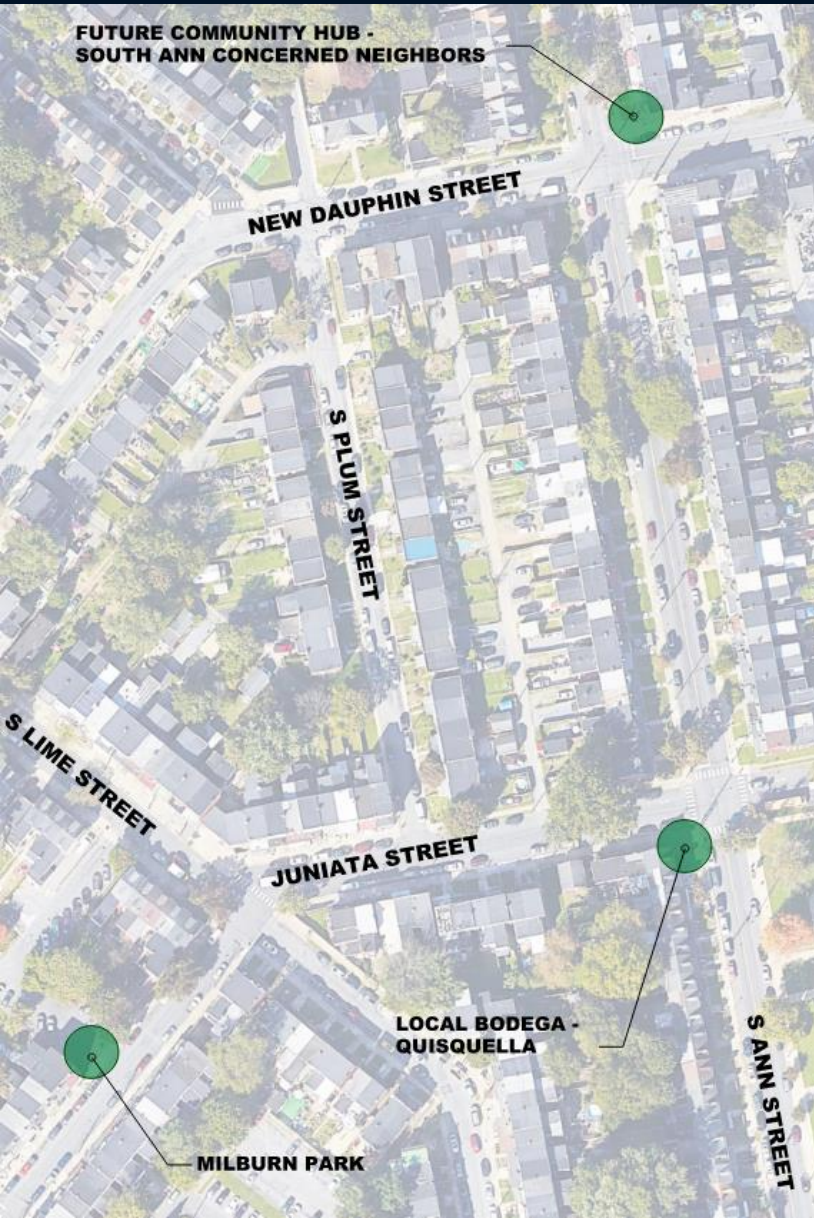
PEDESTRIAN SCALE LIGHTING

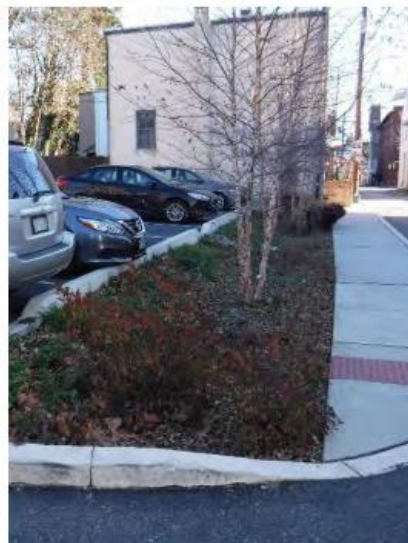

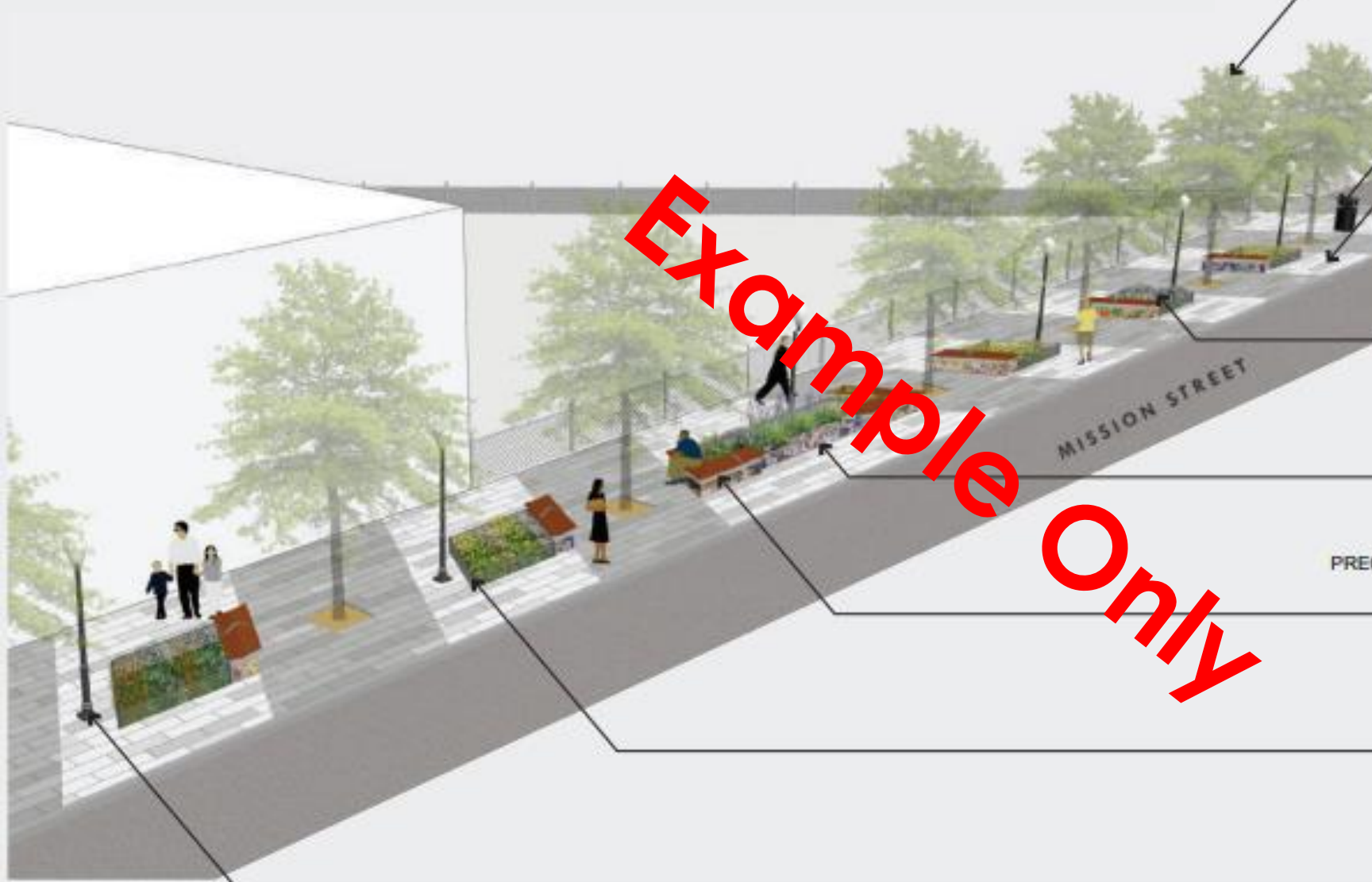

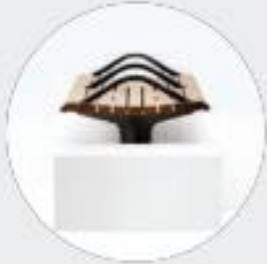
