

# Artful Intersections: Cabbage Hill

## Survey Responses

**1. How often do you travel to, from or through West Strawberry, South Mulberry, and West Vine Streets? | ¿Con qué frecuencia viaja hacia, desde o a través de las calles West Strawberry, South Mulberry y West Vine?**

- Wide range of answers, somewhat evenly spread
- Most common: “Sometimes | A veces”
  - 37 responses with this answer
- Least common: “Never | Nunca”
  - 9 responses with this answer
- 126 people answered this question and of that number, 117 people said they use the intersection in some capacity

TOP ANSWER: Sometimes

**2. What modes of transportation do you most often use when passing through this intersection? Please check all that apply. | ¿Qué medios de transporte utiliza más a menudo cuando pasa por esta intersección? Por favor, marque todos los que correspondan.**

- Walking and Driving are the two most common answers
  - Walking- 60 responses (48%)
  - Driving- 73 responses (58%)
- People could choose more than one answer so there is some overlap in answers
- 124 responses to this question

TOP ANSWER: Driving most common mode of transportation through this intersection

**3. If you live in this neighborhood, how many cars are in your household? | Si vive en este vecindario, ¿cuántos automóviles hay en su hogar?**

- Three possible answers
- Just above 1/3 of people who responded have no car (38%)
- Most people have 1-2 cars, making up 50% of the data
- 10 people (10% of responses) answered that they have more than 2 cars in their household

TOP ANSWER: 1-2 cars per household

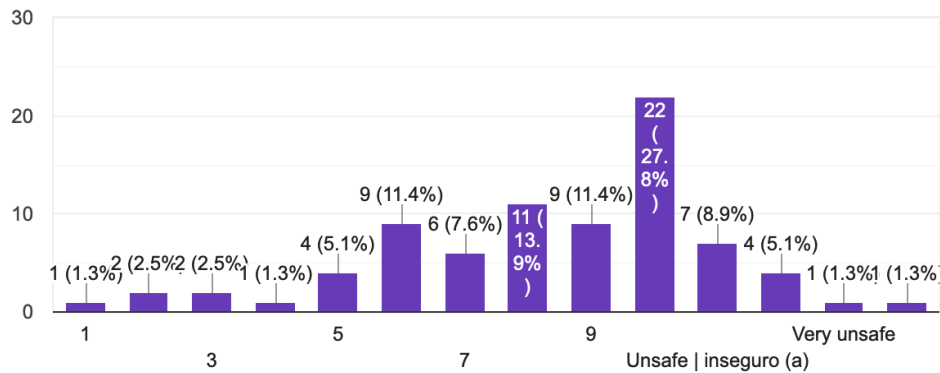
**4. How often do you park on West Vine Street or West Strawberry Street? | ¿Con qué frecuencia se estaciona/parquea en la calle West Vine o en la calle West Strawberry?**

- 61 people said they never park on West Vine St or West Strawberry St
  - 50% of responses
- 37% percent of people responded that they sometimes or occasionally park here
  - 46 responses out of 121
- Only 16 people of 121 said that they always or often park here (11%)

TOP ANSWER: Never

**5. As a pedestrian, bicyclist, how safe do you feel using the road at the intersection? | Como peatón o ciclista, ¿qué seguridad siente al utilizar la calle en la intersección?**

- This question is more easily understood by viewing the graph:



- Possible answers were 1-10
  - Most answers fall above 6

**6. If you don't feel safe using this intersection, tell us why. | Si no se siente seguro(a) utilizando esta intersección, díganos por qué.**

- Note: 78 people had some response for this question, 59% of responses
- Common themes in written answers:
  - Lack of visibility
  - Pedestrians feel unsafe
  - Bikers feel unsafe
  - Cars parking in crosswalk
  - Dangerous for children
  - Cars coming from all directions, speeding through intersection
  - Hard to cross if you don't know the traffic patterns

- “I DO feel safe, but that is because I know the traffic patterns, and therefore know that the safest place to cross is not in any one of the crosswalks.”

**7. Do you ever use the bench at the Veteran’s Memorial between West Strawberry, West Vine, and St. Joseph streets? | ¿Utiliza alguna vez la banca en el Monumento a los Veteranos entre las calles West Strawberry, West Vine y St. Joseph?**

- 96 people said that they do not use this bench (80%)
- 25 people said they do use the bench (20%)

## **Asphalt Art | Arte en asfalto**

**8. What design elements for the art would you like to see? Please check all that apply. | ¿Qué elementos de diseño para el arte le gustaría ver? Por favor, marque todo lo que corresponda.**

- Respondent are interested mostly in nature elements (this is the top answer)
- Interest in bright colors
- 3rd top answer is geometric shapes

**9. Are there any specific symbols, themes, or historic elements that you would like to see reflected in the art? Please describe here. | ¿Hay símbolos específicos, temas o elementos históricos que le gustaría ver reflejados en el arte? Por favor, descríbalos aquí.**

- Historical figures for the community (specific to cabbage hill)
  - Dinah McIntire
- Cabbage, strawberries, mulberries, etc.
- Diversity, inclusion, BLM, celebrating a diverse community
- BIPOC
- History of the neighborhood specifically, not just general lancaster history

Takeaway: Make design specific to the neighborhood, not just generic design/symbols

**10. What do you think would make the area more pleasant? Check all that apply. | ¿Qué cree que haría al área más agradable? Elija todo lo que corresponda.**

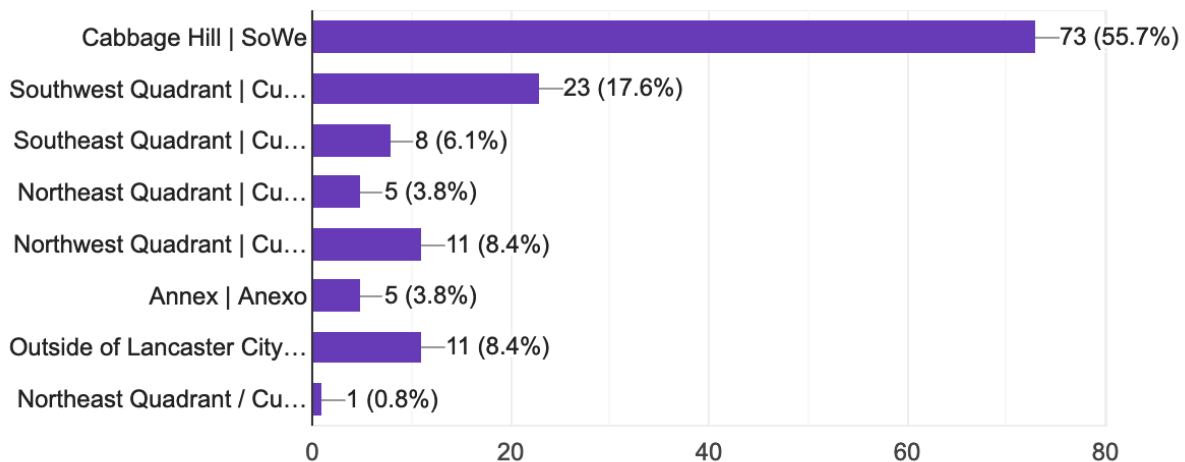
- This question had most people answering that all of these options seemed nice
- Of these, public art and planters were the most popular

Takeaway: All options are popular and people just want to see beautification

## Comments | Comentarios

- “This street is dangerous for my grandkids, I live on Vine up the hill and can’t let myself grand babies out to ride bikes to the park because I don’t trust the cars especially when they are from people that don’t live in this neighborhood and speed”
- “traffic light”
- “Parking is a huge issue in this neighborhood. Any reduction in parking is NOT acceptable and would show complete disregard for the people who live here and the things that really matter to them. If this project is going to mean a net loss of parking spaces, I will personally knock on every door I can to get this community engaged. They need to know exactly what is being proposed and what it will mean.”
- “Very excited about this project!”
- “Planters will not be taken care of unless they are right in front of someone's house. Benches will create a privacy invasion unless they are away from houses. Parking needs to be increased, not reduced. Parking is a critical element.”
- “Parking is a bigger issue than traffic, as this is not a particularly dangerous intersection. I would like to see creative use of the space that incorporates increased parking options for the residences of this neighborhood.”
- “Will Cabbage Hill residents be able to help the artists paint the mural?”
