The City of Lancaster needs feedback from people who live, work and play in this neighborhood to make South Duke Street a safer, more community-friendly place. Data shows that things like more visible crosswalks, lighting, better sidewalks and bike lanes can all help reduce accidents and injuries.

Study Area

Chesapeake Street to Church Street

Treatment Options

Option 1 - Two-Way Separated Bike Lane

- 10' wide on-street two-way bicycle facility separated from motor vehicle traffic
- Sidewalk rehab and curb bumpouts
- Shared use path from Church Street to North Street

Option 2 - Shared Use Path

- 10' wide two-way asphalt path behind curb for people walking and bicycling
- Sidewalk rehab and curb bumpouts
- Angled on-street parking between Chester Street and Susquehanna Street
